Introduction

Road accident is one of the most common disasters worldwide. The degree of accidents varies from place to place and time to time. India has about 1 % of the world's vehicles but accounts for about 10 % of the World's Road Crash fatalities. Every 3.5 minutes one accident takes the life of one person in India. Bihar is on 10th position of road accidents in India, while Patna has jumped from 5th to 4th position in Road accident in India. This is an alarming condition of Patna. The World report on road traffic injury prevention calls for governments to make road safety a political priority, and highlights recommendations with regard to policy, legislation and enforcement, and development of institutional capacity to improve road safety [Peden et al., 2004].

According to our previous study on "Causes of Road Accidents in Patna" in 2016 the conclusion was the fact that drunken driving lead to accidents highest & tired driving is in lowest risk in leading highest road accident. Traffic safety rules, signs & awareness of road safety are mandatory to minimize the risk of road accidents not only in Patna but also in Bihar, whereas it was recommended that awareness on road safety rules, signs & proper training of traffic staff is required in Bihar. We also recommended that the better trainings of the learner drivers and testing techniques for issuing the licence will also reduce number of accidents. Awareness program on road safety from the student level will also assist in reducing the accidents at all levels. We should conduct road safety awareness campaign across the year.

PRESENT STUDY

In continuation of the Road Safety Campaign with tag line "YES! I FOLLOW ROAD SAFETY RULES" Sankalp Jyoti & Safety Alliance again conducted another study on Road Safety in association with "Indian Road Safety Campaign & iSAFE" in Patna district of Bihar. The title of the study was "AWARENESS OF TRAFFIC POLICE, COMMUTERS & OTHERS ON TRAFFIC RULES & SIGNS". The study was conducted at ten high traffic points of Patna district of Bihar. These points are Dakbunglow chowk, Boring Road chowk, Kargil chowk, Patna City chowk, Dinkar Golambar chowk, Kankarbagh Auto Stand, Mithapur Bus Stand, Zero Mile, Anishabad Chowk, & Danapur Bus Stand from 28th August'2017 to 06th September'2017 & interacted with 25 persons (Bikers-05, Car Drivers-05, Auto Drivers-04, Heavy Vehicle Drivers-03 Rickshaw pullers-03, Cycling-02 & Pedestrian-03) at each point. The targeted respondents were Traffic Police, Administrative Police, Commuters & others.

Apart from the study we found that following causes are also responsible for road accidents:

- Uses of water bottles at driving seat
- Over age of commercial drivers result of low vision/inattentiveness
- Migration of drivers from rural traffic to urban traffic
- Use of laser light with high beam
- Irregular stoppage of vehicles
- Mix Traffic

Age Wise Sample Distribution

Maximum numbers of respondents were young and teenagers as the largest group i.e. 64% respondents were belonging to the age group 15-35 years followed by 36-45 years age group 34%. The older respondents i.e., between the age group 46-60 years were only 2% of the total sample population.

Profile of the Respondents:

In this survey 179(68%) male & 82(32%) female were participated. The age group of respondent was above 15-18 years (19%), 19-30 years (62%), 31-40 years (14%) 41-50 Years (3%) and 51 Above (2%) out of 261 were actively participated. 83 respondents were Two wheeler, 54 respondents were LMV, 33 respondents were HMV, 59 respondents were pedestrian, 32 respondents were Three wheeler driver out of 261 respondents. In this survey, we also targeted 37 traffic police to find out their awareness level on traffic rules & signs. We found a remarkable sign of awareness level among the interacted deputed traffic police i.e. only 12% have sufficient knowledge on traffic rules & signs out of 37 traffic police.

Recommendations:

From this study we recommended that awareness & training on road safety rules & signs is needed not only for vehicle drivers but also for commuters & traffic police. Infrastructure development for road safety is missing and hence develops sub-way & foot over bridge on the roads. We would have to careful on awareness to use right way of seat belt, road safety signs, use of horn in vehicles, parking of vehicles and required documents to make driving license.

Conclusion:

From this study it is concluded that the maximum number of commuters violated the traffic rules & signs despite they have much knowledge & don't follow other than the commuters with lack of awareness. They are more hazardous than others. It has been also observed that the deputed traffic police have not much knowledge on road safety rules & signs. The administration of Patna will have to take immediate action on it & prepare action to manage the violation of traffic rules by capacity building & awareness of themselves on it.
